As Growth Loses Steam

Beijing: China plans measures to support household spending on everything from electric appliances to furniture as part of a package of policies to arrest a deepening economic slowdown.

Local authorities should encourage residents to refurbish their homes, and people should get better access to credit to buy household products, according to a plan on boosting consumption released jointly by 13 government departments.

The measures come as a day after China posted weaker-than-expected economic growth for the second quarter as retail sales cooled, the property market downturn deepened, and youth unemployment hit a new high.

The 11-point package is aimed at "unleashing the potential of household consumption," according to the statement issued on the Ministry of Commerce website.

Households will get support to buy new smart home appliances, while regions where conditions are right should provide "appropriate" subsidies or discounted loans for purchases of low-carbon construction materials, it said.

Financial institutions will also be encouraged to boost credit support for purchases of goods for the home, the document said. Loans and maturities should be set at "reasonable" levels, it added.

The CSI 300 consumer discretionary index of stocks was up 0.9% as of 1:12 p.m. local time, erasing earlier losses of up to 1.2%, as traders responded positively to the policy announcement.



Monday's official economic data prompted several banks including Citigroup Inc. to cut their growth forecasts for China this year, with some even warning that the government's 5% target was now at risk.

The National Development and Reform Commission, China's top economic planning body, had hinted at more measures to support consumption in a briefing with reporters earlier on Tuesday.

"Promoting consumption is currently the key to restoring and expanding demand," Jin Xiangdong, director of the NDRC's new research office, said. "People's ability and expectation on consumption is still rather weak and the infrastructure and environment for consumption need to be improved."

A slew of "pragmatic and effective" steps will be applied to boost purchases of big-ticket items, cars, electronic products, as well as consumption in rural areas, he said. **Bloomberg**

London: Rishi Sunak's final Migration Bill is set to become law after clearing its final parliamentary hurdle, in a rare boost to the UK prime minister as he struggles to keep his pledge to stop asylum seekers entering by boat.

The government won a series of votes on the legislation in the House of Lords on Monday night, ending a weeks-long effort by some members of the upper chamber to amend Sunak's controversial legislation, which places a legal duty on the government to detain and remove people who come to the UK by crossing the English Channel in small boats.

In an unexpected win for the premier, amendments that sought to offer safeguards for

White passage of the law is a boost for Sunak, and technically delivers on a pledge he made earlier this year to "pass new laws to stop small boats, making sure that if you come to this country illegally, you are detained and swiftly removed." It's unclear how the legislation will immediately prevent further small boat crossings.

Singapore Passport Named World's Most Powerful, Replacing Japan's

Singapore: Singapore has replaced Japan for having the world's most powerful passport, allowing visa-free entry to 192 global destinations, according to the latest Henley Passport Index.

After five years at the top, Japan dropped to third place as the number of destinations its passport can access without a visa fell, according to the ranking published by London-based immigration consultancy Henley & Partners.

The US, which once topped the ranking nearly a decade ago, slid two places to eighth place. The UK, after a Brexit-induced slump, jumped two places to fourth, a position it held last in 2017.

Singapore is a magnet for wealth, with a recent influx driven by a crackdown on private enterprise in China and fears over geopolitical tensions. But landing the privilege to use the city-state's travel document isn't easy. The nation of 5.5 million granted citizenship to about 20,000 people last year, and authorities earlier this year cut out 500 based on the net worth of individuals. Henley's ranking tracks data from the International Air Transport Association. The methodology differs from other passport indexes like one published by Arab Emirates in pole position last year. **Bloomberg**

Russia Strikes Ukraine Ports After Pulling Out of Grain Export Deal

Defence ministry says that as 'revenge strike' in response to attack on Crimean bridge, it has bombed Odesa and Mykolaiv

Moscow: Russia's Defence Ministry said on Tuesday it had hit military and civilian Ukrainian port cities overnight on a "massive strike" in response to an attack on the Crimean bridge the previous day which it blamed on Kyiv. The ministry said it had struck Odesa, where the Ukrainian navy has its headquarters, and Mykolaiv, near Ukraine's Black Sea coast.

"The armed forces of the Russian Federation carried out a military operation overnight using precision sea-based weapons against facilities where terrorist acts against the Russian Federation were being prepared using uncrewed boats," the ministry said in a statement. It said it had struck a ship repair plant near Odesa where such boats - thought to be naval drones of the kind Russia believes were used to attack the Crimean bridge - were being built.

"In addition, storage facilities holding around 70,000 tons of fuel used to supply the Ukrainian military's equipment were destroyed" near the cities of Mykolaiv and Odesa, it said. It said all the targets had been struck and destroyed, citing fires and detonations as evidence. Reuters could not independently confirm the account.

The ministry said earlier that six Kalibr cruise missiles and 31 out of 36 drones had been shot down, mostly over the coastal Odesa and Mykolaiv regions in the south.

A Russian couple was killed and their 14-year-old daughter wounded on Monday in what Moscow said was a Ukrainian attack that knocked out the road part of the bridge linking Russia to Crimea, which Moscow annexed from Ukraine in 2014. Kyiv has not claimed responsibility for the attack.

Ukrainian media said Ukrainian security services had used naval drones to attack the bridge, which had only recently returned to full operation after suffering severe damage in a similar attack last October. Kremlin spokesman Dmitry Peskov said on Tuesday it had been clear to Moscow from the start that Ukraine was behind the attack, which prompted some Russian tourists to flee Crimea by driving through parts of southern Ukraine controlled by Russian forces.

John Kerry meets Chinese officials

US climate envoy John Kerry told China's top diplomat on Tuesday that President Joe Biden's administration is "very committed" to stabilizing relations between the world's two biggest economies, as the countries seek to restart high-level contacts. On his second day of talks in Beijing, Kerry met with the ruling Communist Party's head of foreign relations Wang Yi, telling him Biden hoped the two countries could "achieve efforts together that can make a significant difference to the world."

Ties between the countries have hit a historic low amid disputes over tariffs, access to technology, human rights and China's threats against self-governing Taiwan.

In his opening remarks, Wang said the sides had suffered from a lack of communication, but that China believes through renewed dialogue "we can find a proper solution to any problems."

"Sometimes, small problems can become big problems," Wang said, adding that dialogue must be conducted on



an "equal basis." That was an apparent reference to US criticism of China's aggressive foreign policy, rights abuses against Muslim and Buddhist minorities and travel sanctions against officials ranging from the Beijing-appointed leader of Hong Kong to the country's defence minister.

Coinciding with Kerry's visit, former US national security adviser and secretary of state, Henry Kissinger, arrived in Beijing this week and met with Defence Minister Li

Shangfu on Tuesday.

China's Defence Ministry quoted Li as praising the role the 100-year-old Kissinger played in opening up China-US relations in the early 1970s, but said bilateral ties had hit a low point because of "some people on the American side who are not willing to meet China halfway."

"We are constantly striving to establish stable, predictable and constructive China-US relations and hope that the US side will join with the Chinese

side in consolidating the consensus of the two countries' leaders and jointly advance the healthy and stable development of relations between our countries and their militaries," Li was quoted as saying.

China claims the island as its own territory to be brought under its control by force if necessary, threatening to draw the US into a major conflict in a region crucial to the global economy.

Contacts have only slowly been restored and China continues to refuse to restart dialogue between the People's Liberation Army, the party's military branch, and the US Department of Defence.

Kerry is the third senior Biden administration official in recent weeks to travel to China for meetings with their counterparts following Secretary of State Antony Blinken and Treasury Secretary Janet Yellen. Kerry said he appreciated the

opportunity to "change our relationship for the better" and that Biden is "very committed to stability within this relationship and also to achieve efforts together that can make a significant difference to the world."

Biden "values his relationship with President Xi (Jinping), and I think President Xi values his relationship with President Biden, and I know he looks forward to being able to move forward and change the dynamic," Kerry said.

He later paid a courtesy call on newly appointed Premier Li Qiang, the party's second-ranking official, who told him China and the US should cooperate more closely on the "extremely large challenge" posed by global warming.

Kerry responded that "working and showing the rest of the world how we can cooperate and begin to address this with the urgency it requires is incredible."

UK asylum-seekers barge arrives as Parliament passes migration bill

A barge that will house up to 500 asylum-seekers arrived Tuesday in England after Parliament passed its long-debated bill to curb migration. The Bibby Stockholm was pulled by a tug into Portland after the government's controversial legislation won passage after overcoming resistance in the House of Lords.

The boat and the bill are both parts of Prime Minister Rishi Sunak's strategy to stop migrants from making risky English Channel crossings in small boats. The legislation will become law after receiving the assent of King Charles III.

The Conservative government has pledged to "stop the boats" — overcrowded dinghies and other small craft that cross from northern France carrying migrants who hope to live in the UK. More than 45,000 people crossed the Channel to Britain in 2022; several died in the attempt.

The bill is intended to deter those journeys and prevent migrants from claim-

ing asylum in the UK if they arrive illegally. Under the legislation, those caught will be sent back home or deported to another safe country, and banned from ever re-entering the UK. The government planned to send some of those who arrive without authorisation to Rwanda, but last month the Court of Appeal ruled it was illegal. The government plans to appeal to the UK Supreme Court.

The bill was approved after an all-night tussle Monday between the House of Commons, where the governing Conservatives have a majority, and the unelected House of Lords, which can amend but not block legislation.

Elected members of Parliament defeated amendments that would have included protections for modern slavery and child detention limits.

Best of Britain, a group that aims to maintain strong international ties after Brexit, said the bill will deny refugees and asylum-seekers their rights under international law and

will lead to more people being detained at taxpayer cost.

"This cruel bill will now give the government the green light to flout international law and mistreat refugees to distract from their own failure to fix the problems they created when ministers closed safe routes to asylum," Naomi Smith, CEO of Best for Britain, said in a statement. "This policy is not only morally repugnant, it is totally unworkable."

Murray, the undersecretary of state for the Home Office and member of House of Lords, urged his peers to pass the bill, saying the UK's asylum system was overwhelmed and taxpayers were paying 6 million pounds (\$7.8 million) a day to house them.

"If people know there is no way for them to stay in the UK, they won't risk their lives and pay criminals thousands of pounds to arrive here illegally," Murray said.

"It is therefore only right that we stop the boats and break the business model of the criminal gangs exploiting vulnerable people."

Turkish Prez visits Gulf Arab states

Turkish President Recep Tayyip Erdogan travelled to Saudi Arabia on Monday in a three-stop tour of Persian Gulf states to seek trade and investment opportunities for Turkey's floundering economy.

Erdogan arrived in Jeddah accompanied by an entourage of some 200 businesspeople, according to the Foreign Economic Relations Board of Turkey. He met Crown Prince Mohammed bin Salman at Al Salam Palace, shaking hands and attending a welcoming ceremony where he "expressed his happiness with this visit," the state-run Saudi Press Agency reported early Tuesday.

Business forums have been arranged in Saudi Arabia, Qatar and the United Arab Emirates during Erdogan's three-day trip. "We are hoping to improve our relations and cooperation in many fields. We will focus on joint investment and commer-

cial initiatives to be realized in the upcoming period," Erdogan told reporters in Istanbul before leaving. The visit comes as Turks are hit with sales and fuel tax hikes that Finance Minister Mehmet Simsek has said are necessary to restore fiscal discipline and bring inflation down.

The official annual inflation rate stood at 38% last month, down from a high of 85% in October. Independent economists, however, maintain that the actual rate was around 108% in June. Turkey's current account deficit reached record levels this year — \$37.7 billion in the first five months — and Erdogan is hoping the oil- and gas-rich Gulf states will help plug the gap. Last month the Turkish central bank delivered a large interest rate hike, signaling a shift toward more conventional economic policies following criticism that Erdogan's low-rate approach had made a cost-of-living crisis worse.

US sending fighter jets, warship to Gulf region

WASHINGTON (AP)

The US is sending additional fighter jets and a warship to the Strait of Hormuz and Gulf of Oman to increase security in the wake of Iranian attempts to seize commercial ships there.

The Pentagon said Monday that the USS Thomas Hudner, a destroyer, and a number of F-35 fighter jets will be heading to the area. The Hudner had been in the Red Sea.

Defense officials last week announced the deployment of F-16s to the area over the past weekend, and there have been A-10 attack aircraft there for nearly two weeks in response to the Iranian activity.

The latest deployments come after Iran tried to seize two oil tankers near the strait early this month, opening fire on one of them. The aircraft are intended to give air cover for the commercial ships moving through the waterway and increase the military's visibility in the area, as a deterrent to Iran.

The US Navy said in both instances the Iranian naval vessels backed off when the USS McPaul, a guided-missile destroyer, arrived on the scene. The Navy said the McPaul remains in the Gulf region to continue protection of the shipping lanes.

Sabrina Singh, a Pentagon spokeswoman, said it is not clear how long the ship and the aircraft will remain in the region. "In light of this continued threat and in coordination with our partners and allies, the department is increasing our presence and ability to monitor the strait and surrounding waters," Singh told Pentagon reporters during a briefing.

The US Navy says Iran has set at least five commercial vessels in the last two years and has harassed more than a dozen others. Many of the incidents have occurred in and around the Strait of Hormuz, the narrow mouth of the Persian Gulf through which 20 per cent of all crude oil passes.

Israel's president to meet Biden

President Joe Biden on Tuesday is hosting Israel's figurehead president Isaac Herzog at the White House, as they seek to sustain ties despite US concerns over Prime Minister Benjamin Netanyahu's controversial plans to overhaul his country's judicial system and ongoing settlement construction in the West Bank.

Herzog's visit comes a day after Biden spoke with Netanyahu by phone and invited him to meet in the US, this fall, although the president expressed reservations about several of Netanyahu's hard-right coalition's policies. Netanyahu's government is pushing forward with judicial changes that have sparked widespread protest in Israel and he also has authorized the construction of thousands of new housing units in the West Bank. Netanyahu and his allies, a collection of ultra-Orthodox and ultranationalist parties, say the plan is needed to rein in the powers of unelected judges. Opponents say the plan will check Israel's fragile system of checks and balances and move the country toward authoritarian rule.

Herzog has appealed for a compromise that has thus far proven elusive. Many American Jewish groups and Democratic lawmakers have expressed concerns about the plan. During his visit, Herzog is set to meet with Biden, Vice President Kamala Harris and congressional leaders. On Wednesday he will become the second Israeli president, after his father Chaim Herzog, to address Congress. His speech will mark Israel's celebration of its 75th year of independence. Herzog's visit comes weeks after Israeli forces carried out one of their most intensive operations in the West Bank in two decades, with a two-day air and ground offensive in Jenin, a militant stronghold in the occupied West Bank.

Protesters block highways against Netanyahu's judicial overhaul plan

Israeli protesters blocked highways and gathered outside Tel Aviv's stock exchange and military headquarters on Tuesday in the latest country-wide demonstration against Prime Minister Benjamin Netanyahu's planned judicial overhaul.

The latest "day of disruption" came as longtime allies of the prime minister pushed a contentious piece of legislation through a parliamentary committee ahead of a vote expected next week. Additional protests are planned throughout the day, including on the platforms at train stations around the country during the afternoon rush hour.

Demonstrators, many of them military reservists, created human chains and blocked one of the entrances to the Kirya, Israel's military



headquarters in central Tel Aviv. Outside the Tel Aviv stock exchange, demonstrators ignited smoke bombs, drummed and chanted, and held up signs reading "save our startup nation" and "dictatorship will kill the economy." Others demonstrated outside the headquarters of the Histadrut, Israel's largest labor union, demanding the organization calls for a general strike — a move that could paralyse the country's economy.

Protesters scaled scaffolding outside the building and hoisted reservist protest flags. The labour union had called a strike in March, a move that contributed to Netanyahu freezing the judicial overhaul.

'Mystery object washed up on Australian coast could be piece of Indian rocket'

A dome-shaped mysterious object has washed up on a remote Australian beach, amid speculation that it could be from a 20-year-old Indian rocket that was used for launching a satellite. The canister was discovered near the beach in Green Head in Western Australia (WA) about 250 kilometres north of the city of Perth on Saturday.

When contacted by PTI, the Indian Space Research Organisation (ISRO) sources confirmed receipt of a formal communication from the Australian Space Agency. However, they did not provide the details. The bizarre-looking

object has been declared a piece of space junk, while national agencies, including the Australian Space Agency (ASA), continue working to identify its origin.

"At this time, it is believed the item is space debris and will be managed as such until it can be determined otherwise," Western Australia Police said in a statement.

However, a space expert says the object could be from a 20-year-old Indian rocket. European Space Agency engineer Andrea Boyd said experts believed the item fell from an Indian rocket launching a satellite, the Australian Broadcasting Corporation reported.

UK's primary domestic terror threat from Islamist terrorism, says report

The primary domestic terrorist threat to the UK comes from Islamist terrorism even as explicit affiliation to terrorist groups such as Al Qaeda and Islamic State is making way for wider online extremist influences, according to a new British government report tabled in Parliament on Tuesday.

"CONTEST: The United Kingdom's Strategy for Countering Terrorism 2023" was presented to the House of Commons by Home Secretary Suella Braverman, who highlighted the report's findings of a "persistent and evolving" threat to the country from Islamist groups overseas.

The Indian-origin minister



said her department will use the updated version of the report to adopt a more agile and aligned approach to counter the terrorist threat. "We judge that the risk from terrorism is rising, and we must do everything within our power to reduce it," said Braverman in a written statement to the Commons. "Since the last version of CONTEST was published in 2018, nine terrorist attacks have been declared in the UK, in which six people

died and 20 people were injured. Overseas, 24 UK nationals have been killed in 11 terrorist attacks. The majority of these attacks were Islamist in nature," she said.

The minister told Parliament that the latest report sets out a need to respond to domestic terrorist threat which is "less predictable and harder to detect and investigate, a persistent and evolving threat from Islamist groups overseas, and an operating environment where accelerating advances in technology provide both opportunity and risk to our counter-terrorism efforts." It also includes a greater focus on the pivotal role of ideology in encouraging extremism. Through this updated strategy, and by taking a more agile,

integrated and aligned approach, we will do everything within our power to keep the public safe," she said.

The report warns that groups affiliated with Al Qaeda and Islamic State, referred to as Daesh, now operate with relative freedom in more territory than ever before and have in some cases been "re-energised" by the Western withdrawal from Afghanistan two years ago.

"In the UK, the primary domestic terrorist threat comes from Islamist terrorism, which accounts for approximately 67 per cent of attacks since 2018, about three quarters of M15 caseload and 64 per cent of those in custody for terrorism-connected offences," the report states.
